FRANÇOIS VIVIER – ARCHITECTE NAVAL

Beg-Meil is a traditional cruiser sloop, just like many that existed in the old days. It is elegant and seaworthy with its half-deck made of varnished wood, and its metal centreboard capable of pivoting which provides stability and performance. It can be used as a cruiser, as a fishing boat, and even as a race boat with an agile rudder. It has the same length as the Cormoran but offers the advantage of being lighter, so it has a smaller sail and can be easily put into water from a trailer. You can navigate alone, or with a crew of 3 and even 5. Its construction is based on either strip planking, or clincher mounting of marine plywood on plywood bulkheads. Especially the clincher-built plywood version is very easy to build. Hull shapes are the same as Ilur. Ilur is a reference sailing – rowing boat, with nearly 1000 plans already sold. The first Beg-Mail named Pepito, built by the amateur boat builder Benoit Brahant using a kit supplied by Icarai, was put into water in Carnac in July 2005. You can see our photo album. Many others are actually under construction, one being in La Réunion.
